The first workshop will be held from July 20 - July 31, 2009, at the Wissenschaftskolleg in Berlin, Germany.

The second workshop will be held in Ann Arbor, Michigan, in the Summer of 2010.

These workshops are supported by a grant from the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation and the Alexander v.
